



# #demi dancer

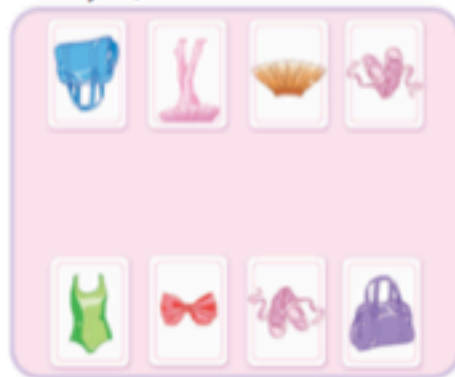
It's a Dance Class Dash!

You've packed your dance gear: shoes, leggings, tutu, leotard, bow, but do they match? Well, you better run and hope for the best.

In this super fast card game, you're getting dressed for dance class and each article must be placed in order over the next item. The first player to play out all of their cards wins the game.

## setup

Shuffle the 54 cards and divide them equally between two players (27 each). Lay out four cards in line, face up in front of you, as shown below.



## how to play

Holding the remaining cards in your hand and face down, both players start at the same time. You can count to three and then each lay down one card between the two rows of four, as shown.



## how to win

The player who is first to play out all their cards in hand and the four cards in front of them is the winner.

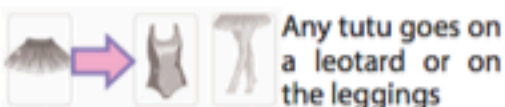

If neither player can place a card from their row of four to the middle two piles, each player counts to three and then plays a card from their hand straight to a middle card pile, just as at the start of the game.

If both players have played out all cards from their hand to their row of four cards, but have a card or cards still remaining in that row and neither player can play onto a middle pile, then each player picks up the right-hand middle pile, shuffles the cards and makes a new hand. Each player then replenishes their own row up to four cards. They each count to three and play one more card from their hands into the middle row and continue playing.

Play cards from your row of four cards onto either of the two piles of cards in the middle.

Cards must be played on the middle piles as follows (as also shown on the diagram on the back of the cards):



As you play cards individually from your row of four cards in front of you, to either of the two piles in the middle, you may replenish to a maximum of four cards in front of you.

You may not play straight from your hand to the two middle card piles, unless starting play.

You can replenish up to four cards in your row at anytime and don't have to wait until all four cards have been played to the middle card piles.
